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## Junior Maths Challenge

Last week was a busy week in the maths department; the Junior Maths Challenge took place, and we finally received the results of the Intermediate Kangaroo that one of our students sat a while ago.

You may remember from a previous newsletter that during lockdown almost sixty of our Year 10 and 11 students sat an online version of the UKMT Intermediate Maths Challenge. Evie Mansell was our top scorer and secured an opportunity to take part in the follow-on round, The Intermediate Kangaroo. We found out this week she got a fantastic score which earned her a Certificate of Merit.

This week it was the turn of our Year 7 and Year 8 students. A few weeks ago, all Year 7 and Year 8 students were given the option to do an extra piece of home learning which was a previous Maths Challenge paper, the top thirty scorers in each year group secured a place to take part in this year's Junior Maths Challenge. On Thursday 29th April, sixty Year 7 and Year 8 students went to IT5 and 6, and with their unique username and password logged on to the Maths Challenge website to complete the challenge. This is the first year we have run the challenge online and the students coped with the new use of technology fantastically well. Stay tuned later in the Month for news of their results.
