The history department would like to take this opportunity to welcome new students joining the school and to say how pleased we are that you have continued your history studies at AS level at Lady Lumley's.

The AS course will be delivered by two history specialists, Mrs Hughes and Mr Fairclough. The AS will consist of two equally weighted units of study which are

- Democracy and Dictatorships in Germany 1919-1963
- England 1485-1558: the Early Tudors

As part of your study you will receive two textbooks to support your learning in each course and in September you will be issued with a course handbook which will contain guidance on the course, a reading list, exam specification and example exam questions. During the first lesson of the term your class teacher will go through this handbook with you, explaining the best ways to use it in and out of class and also talk through any resources you might wish to purchase for yourself.
