## Dear Parent/Carer

We welcome the majority of Year 9 back to face-to-face learning today. Face coverings will no longer be compulsory for students in the corridors or in classrooms from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July although students may choose to wear them. Face coverings will remain compulsory on school and public transport. Please ensure that home testing of students continues, and Lady Lumley's will continue to follow Public Health England guidance on notifying and isolating close contacts for the remainder of this school term.

To reassure parents once again – there will be no change to uniform for September 2021. We have a uniform to promote high standards, promote belonging and safeguarding and to ensure all students present in the same way regardless of background. We will review uniform over the next year and will communicate with students and parents throughout that time. There will be no 'quick change'. If there is a change to uniform, it will be managed gradually ensuring that families can replace uniform as they would normally.

I have written to Students/Parents and Carers outlining the arrangements for results days this year. Please do be in contact with the relevant staff in good time before the school closes on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021 with any remaining queries.

We will be taking every opportunity over the summer break to invest in improving the school site and infrastructure. Work has already started at the weekends at improving the IT cabling and switches. This will continue over the summer, which will give us the ability to access Wi-Fi over the next year. There will also be a fence erected around the school boundary to provide another layer of protection for our students and the site. Work will also be done to update and increase the number of CCTV cameras that maintain the safety of our students during the day and the site out of hours. Within the school, we will have decorators in to give some capacity to our fantastic site staff, focusing this holiday on the corridors and open spaces. This is very welcome investment for Lady Lumley's and will improve the learning environment for students and staff as we return in September 2021.

The arrangements for the return in September will be outlined next week when we have planned for the alterations as outlined in the DfE 'Schools COVID-19 operation guidance'. There is likely to be a staggered start, as there was last year, to accommodate on site lateral flow testing.

From September the school day will end at 3.00pm. For those students who access the bus towards Scarborough there is a timetable attached (Link to doc). As the school day will look slightly different for different year groups to accommodate split lunchtimes, there will be a 'Timings of the School Day' poster in each classroom and in other spaces around school. ## 'Report Remove' - A message from the North Yorkshire Safeguarding Children Partnership

REPORT REMOVE is a new tool to empower children and young people to stop the spread of nude images online. North Yorkshire Safeguarding Children Partnership (NYSCP) is promoting the new Childline and Internet Watch Foundation (IWF) tool which helps children and young people to report a nude image or video of themselves that has been shared online. The IWF can then take steps to remove it from the Internet. Given the recent Ofsted report and research from many other organisations, we know there are many reasons for taking/sharing and equally many barriers to reporting images and videos. It is therefore imperative that young people know that they can take action themselves and that something will be done.

Importantly, a young person can even report an image/video that hasn't been uploaded and shared. The IWF will assign a 'hash' (a digital fingerprint) to prevent the image being uploaded by anyone.


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
