Student Financial Support

(16-19 year olds – 2021/22)



The following support is provided by the School so that financial issues are not a barrier to successful completion of your studies.

Entitlement for all students

- Free textbooks and materials essential to your courses and a printing allowance
- Free examination entries (excluding re-sits)
- Access to free or low-cost extra-curricular activities (e.g. sport)
- Eligibility for NUS card, which gives access to various on-line and in-store discounts

Guaranteed Bursary

You may be eligible to apply for a bursary of £1,200 a year if:-

- You are in or recently left local authority care
- you get Income Support or Universal Credit in your name
- you get Disability Living Allowance (DLA) in your name and either Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) or Universal Credit
- you get Personal Independence Payment (PIP) in your name and either ESA or Universal Credit

To apply for this bursary please complete an application form for Student Financial Support (FS01) available from the Sixth Form Office. Please apply asap - initial deadline 31 October 2021.

Discretionary Funds

If you are from a low income household*, then you are eligible to apply for Grants towards school - related costs (e.g. bus fares to school, school lunches, trips, exam re-sits, university visits and UCAS fees).

To apply for these funds please complete an application form for Student Financial Support (FS01) available from the Sixth Form Office. There are limited funds, so please apply as early as possible. Attendance, behaviour and academic progress will be factors taken into consideration.

* We define "low income" in line with the government's 2010/11 eligibility criteria for maximum EMA payment (i.e. £20,817 annual income but will consider applications for households with annual incomes up to £35,000 – we will require Tax Credit Award Notice for 6/4/20 to 5/4/21 as evidence of income for all claims

Other Funds and Support

You may also be able to ask for financial help from the Lady Lumley's Foundation and the Care to Learn grant is available to help with childcare costs.
