**New Positive Behaviour for Learning Policy**

This week we have introduced our new Positive Behaviour for Learning Policy. We have listened to student, parent/carer and staff voice and reviewed the policy. The biggest change is the culture shift to focus on the positives and rewards. We have asked Tutor Groups to discuss what rewards they would like. Students will be able to purchase these rewards with the points they are awarded for displaying Positive behaviour in class and around school. We are really excited to read the student's ideas!

Once the staff and students are used to the new systems we will be launching a new App called ClassCharts; this will allow you to track your child's positive and negative behaviour points – we will be in touch soon about this.
