The judge concluded that Mair wanted to advance white supremacism and exclusive nationalism. Pickering Surgery COVID Vaccinations

Did your 12-15 year old miss out on their covid vaccination at school? Is your 16 or 17 year old due their second or booster dose?

Vaccination is the most effective way to reduce serious illness from Covid and protect your child and loved ones.

Pickering surgery are offering appointments for vaccination on Saturday 29th January. Consent to vaccinate 12-15 year olds is in two parts – a phone call with a parent or carer the day before, and again with the child on the day. 16 and 17 year olds can book directly online. Please ring the surgery on 01751 471296 (option 2) to book both appointments.

Please note 16 and 17 year olds are due a booster 91 days post second dose and all healthy children must wait 12 weeks following Covid infection before they can be vaccinated.
