The price includes:

- Coach to and from Manchester airport
- 2 x Airport Transfer in Krakow
- Hotel bed and breakfast at the Hotel Alexander 1
- Evening meals (lunch will not be provided, students will be given opportunity to buy lunch)
- 4 hour Coach Hire in Krakow
- Travel insurance
- Coach Excursion to Auschwitz (maximum 9 hours)
- 3.5 Hour Guided Tour of Auschwitz-Birkenau
- Guide and entrance fees for the Schindler Museum
- Visit to Podgorze The Wartime Ghetto

Your child should have a passport with at least 6 months on it from the date of departure.

It is important that we have a photocopy of the passport as soon as possible. This is needed for the flight details.





Your child must have an EHIC card or a GHIC card - please follow the link below.

EHIC: Current European Health Insurance Cards (EHIC) are valid as long as they are in date. When your EHIC has expired you need to apply for a new Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC).

The new GHIC card is free to obtain from the official website and should be applied for at least 4 weeks before travel: https://www.nhs.uk/using-the-nhs/healthcare-abroad/apply-for-a-free-uk-global-health-insurance-card-ghic/

Both cards will offer equivalent protection for emergency and medically necessary healthcare needs when in the EU on holiday.
