


## Going for Gold!

A student commented “Mr Burkeman was very knowledgeable and inspiring to young people about their chosen careers and futures. Oliver Burkeman was educated at Huntington School, York. . He was a student at Christ’s College, at the University of Cambridge and served as editor of the student newspaper Varsity. He graduated in 1994 with a degree in social and political sciences. Oliver is a British author and award-winning journalist, formerly writing the weekly column “This Column Will Change Your Life” for The Guardian. In 2021, he published “Four Thousand Weeks: Time Management for Mortals”, a book on the philosophy and psychology of time management and happiness.
